Amino Chemicals Ltd have requested a declaration from Malta Industrial Parks Ltd in connection with their IPPC requirement for factory MRA061 at Marsa Industrial Estate prior to operation by Amino Chemicals.

Malta Industrial Parks Ltd has tried to establish the date when the factory was built, and any other previous uses before Amino Chemicals. We have managed to trace a photograph dated 1977-1978 which shows the site of A61 still as a field (Photo attached) From our records we have deduced that the building was built for "Contraction and General", a public construction company owned by the government together with property MRA041. Property MRA061 was release for Amino Chemicals which has occupied the premises ever since.

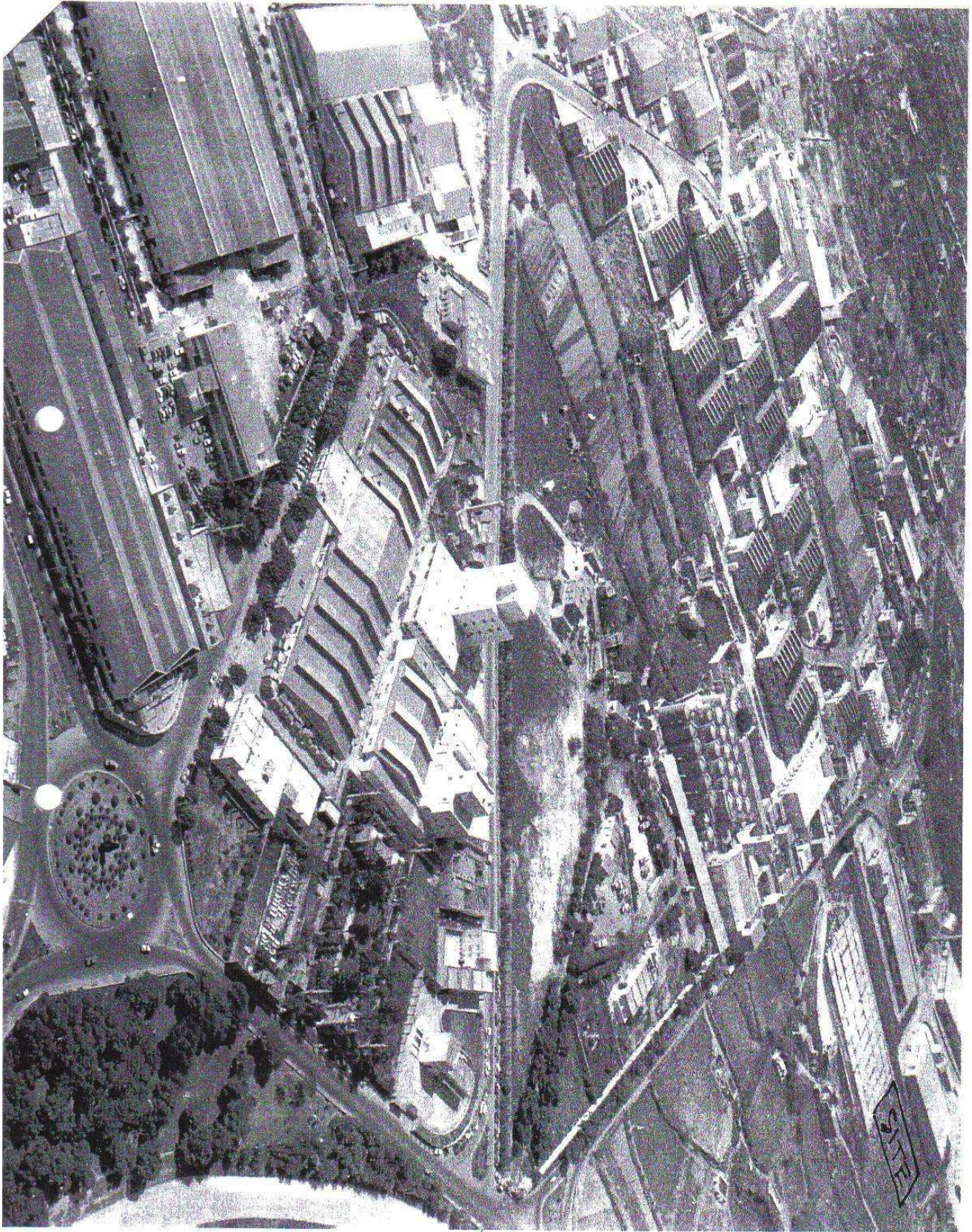

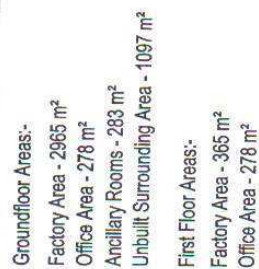

Dear Sir,

We refer to the Site Report prepared by your entity regarding the state of the premises currently occupied by Amino Chemicals, prior to its handing over to the same Amino Chemicals. As point out by your goodselves, this Site Report is an essential part of the IPPC application, and has a barring on the future re-instatement of the premises.

We appreciate your effort in documenting the origins of the factory we now occupy, but we would like to point out that Amino Chemicals first occupied the existing building premises in the second half of 1992, some years after originally being built by 'Contraction and General'.

In fact we found an empty building, previously occupied by some textile firm. The premises was completely empty and barren in all respects.

We would appreciate that this fact is mentioned in the site report, since it may have bearing in the future re-instatement of the premises as dictated by the IPPC.
