FORMAL NOTICE
IPPC Regulations: LN 234 of 2002 as amended by LN 230 of 2004

On 29 November 2006, a meeting was held with yourselves to discuss the process occurring at your installation, where you clarified that in this installation, biodiesel (an ester) is produced by means of a chemical reaction. Thus your installation falls under Section 4.1(b) of Schedule 1 of the IPPC Regulations.

In subsequent correspondence, you were asked to submit an IPPC application, however, to date, this has not been received. Industrial IPPC installations need to be in possession of an IPPC permit to be allowed to operate.

You will understand that failure to obtain an IPPC permit will result in you becoming legally liable under the same Legal Notice and we will be compelled to start legal procedures against you, which will make you liable for the penalties contemplated in the law and for damages resulting from any procedure started by the European Commission.

It is in your interest to treat this matter with urgency.
