Dear Ms Mary Gaerty

Reference is made to your application dated 30<sup>th</sup> January 2013, re- your request for permission to sanction cesspit Site at, L-Imriekeb, Ramla Road, Maghtab next to the Maghtab Landfill and adjacent to Waste serve civic amenity site.

There is no objection to your request subject to the following conditions:

1. Cesspit/s is to be made according to law. Should be of adequate size, easily accessible to a bowser all the year round for the purpose of emptying, made leak-proof and built in such a way as not to contaminate the surrounding area.
2. Applicant has to provide this Directorate a certification from a competent engineer/architect confirming that the cesspit/s once constructed has been tested and confirmed leak-proof and that same has been constructed according to law and of the required size.
3. The Superintendent of Public Health reserves the right to order the abolition of the said cesspit/s when he deems this is necessary and to order the connection of the drains to the public sewer or to adopt any other sewage drainage system.
4. This permit exempts applicant from applying for a permit from the Department for Environmental Health, but does not exempt applicant from applying for other permits, if required, from other Departments or Authorities.

5. The material emptied from the cesspit/s by the bowser, should be discharged in the main public sewer at authorized points only, as directed by the Wastewater Unit within the Water Services Corporation.
6. Cesspits are to be emptied regularly and in no way should foul matter overflow onto nearby areas.
