Decision Notice for the determination of IP0001/22

Dear Ms Gaerty,

Reference is made to the above mentioned Environmental Permit application and the ERA Board's determination of the said application.

In the sitting of 6th December 2024, the ERA Board considered your application favourably for a period of ten (10) years, subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions as post-decision requirements prior to the granting of the permit:

1. Submission of bank guarantee of € 36,500;
2. Payment of €18,350 in relation to OWK0035/19;
3. Installation of bunding within the waste storage sheds to prevent any run-off within the sheds from reaching the gutter just outside the sheds (Previously IP Item 7);
4. Submission of a method statement for monitoring of dust in line with applicable BAT conclusions (Previously IP Item 11a); and
5. Recertification by a third party warranted engineer or architect of site impermeability. This shall include all gutters, sumps, cesspits, oil/water interceptors, tanks and reservoirs collecting industrial effluent. These shall be certified to meet the criteria laid out in S.L. 549.45 (Previously IP Item 13).

The post-decision requirements are to be fulfilled at the earliest and not later than six months from the date of this letter. The applicant is to inform ERA upon completion of this condition so as to proceed with granting of said permit. Non-fulfilment of this condition shall result in the dismissal of the decision. This letter shall not be construed as a permit to undertake any activity on site.

Any aggrieved person may appeal from this decision before the Environment and Planning Review Tribunal within 30 days from the issue of this letter in terms of Article 63 of the Environment Protection Act.
