Holqien ta' skart

Minhabba li l-proġett qed jipproponi zona ta' rikreazzjoni b' intervent minimu, mhux probabbli li l-proġett se jinvolvi kwantitajiet kbar ta' skart solidu. Il-proġett x'aktarx li johloq kwantitajiet żgħira ta' skart inerti u municijali li faċli jkunu ġestiti.

Waste generation

*Since the nature of the project seeks to establish a recreational area with minimal intervention, it is unlikely that the project will involve large quantities of solid waste. The project is likely to generate small, easily manageable quantities of inert and municipal waste.*

Impatt fuq il-kwalità tal-arja, storbju u vibrazzjonijiet

Huwa mistenni li se jkun hemm xi storbju, vibrazzjonijiet u impatti fuq il-kwalità l-arja, l-aktar matul il-fażi ta' kostruzzjoni. Madankollu, dawn aktarx li se jkunu minimi u ta' natura temporanja. Għandhom ikunu infurzati miżuri *standard* biex jittaffa l-impatt waqt il-kostruzzjoni skont ir-Regolamenti fuq il-Ġestjoni Ambjentali ta' Sit tal-Kostruzzjoni (Avviż Legali 295 tal-2007). Waqt l-operat, il-proġett se jgħib zieda fin-numru ta' viżitaturi, li possibbilment iwassal għal livelli oġhla ta' storbju, iżda madankollu dan mhux mistenni li jkun konsiderevoli.

Impact on air quality, noise and vibrations

*Noise, vibration and impacts on air quality are expected, mainly during the construction phase, however these are likely to be minimal and of a temporary nature. Standard mitigation measures during construction should be enforced in accordance with the Environmental Management Construction Site Regulations (Legal Notice 295 of 2007). During operation, the project will entail an increase in visitor numbers, which would possibly lead to increased noise levels, however this is not expected to be considerable*

Impatt permezz ta' dawl

Matul il-lejl, aktarx li se jkun hemm tidwil tal-moġhdijiet u zoni ta' rikreazzjoni. Madankollu, l-emissjonijiet tad-dawl jistgħu jitnaqqsu permezz tal-użu ta' lampi li jharsu 'l isfel (*down-lighters*), jew billi jitnaqqas id-dawl użat.

Light pollution

*During night time, lighting along pathways and recreational areas is envisaged. Nevertheless, light emissions may be reduced through the use of down-lighters, or by minimisation of lighting.*
