ACCORDING to Part V (Containment and Eradication of Plant Pests) of the Plant Quarantine Act (Cap. 433) of the Laws of Malta, and Article 6 of the Commission Decision 2007/365/EC on Emergency Measures to Prevent the Introduction into and the Spread within the Community of *Rhynchophorus Ferrugineus (Olivier)* and its amendments, the island of Gozo is being defined as a demarcated area for Red Palm Weevil. The Plant Health Directorate within the Ministry for Resources and Rural Affairs is taking the necessary actions to control this harmful organism.

IN conformity with Regulation 3(8) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (Legal Notice 114 of 2007), and in view of the fact that MEPA has determined that the proposal is unlikely to have significant environmental impacts, the Director of Environment Protection agrees that the proposal does not require the preparation of an Environmental Planning Statement (EPS).

The Project Description Statement (PDS) presented as part of the application has considered the environmental issues in a sufficient manner such that the preparation of an EPS would not add any new information and MEPA has all the necessary information to determine the application. From the information presented in the PDS and screening according to Schedule IB of the same Regulations, the proposal is not likely to have significant environmental effects.

Holqien ta' skart

Il-proġett se jiġġenera l-iskart kemm waqt il-kostruzzjoni kif ukoll waqt l-operat. Matul il-fażi tal-kostruzzjoni, se jinholq skart inert, madankollu l-kwantitajiet x'aktarx li jkun żgħar. Il-ħamrija li se titneħħa se titqiegħed f'partijiet oħra tas-sit jew inkella se terġa' tintuża 'l barra mis-sit skont ma jkun approvat mill-awtoritajiet rilevanti. L-iskart prodott waqt l-operat se jintrema skont il-proċeduri stabbiliti għall-immaniġġar tal-iskart. Kull materjal/skart perikoluż mhux ser jinħażen fuq is-sit u se jiġi rregolat permezz ta' reġistrazzjoni ambjentali.

Waste generation

The project will generate waste during both construction and operation. During the construction phase, inert waste will be generated however quantities are likely to be minimal. Cleared soil will either be shifted to other parts of the development site itself or reused off-site as approved by the relevant authorities. Municipal waste produced during operation will be disposed of in accordance with established waste management procedures. Any hazardous material/waste will not be stored on site and will be regulated through an environmental registration.

Impatt fuq il-kwalità tal-arja

Waqt il-kostruzzjoni, huwa mistenni li jitqanqlu xi trabijiet mit-tindif u t-tħaffir tas-sit, u li se jkun hemm xi emissjonijiet ta' NOx mill-inġenji. Madankollu, l-ebda impatt sinifikanti m'hu mistenni dment li r-Regolamenti fuq il-Ġestjoni Ambjentali ta' Sit tal-Kostruzzjoni (Avviż Legali 295 ta' 2007) jiġu osservati. Waqt l-operat, se jinholqu emissjonijiet ta' NOx mit-traffiku operattiv iżda minħabba l-iskala tal-proġett, il-proposta mhux mistennija li se tiġġenera ammonti sinifikanti ta' traffiku.

Impact on air quality

During construction, fugitive dust from site clearance and excavation, and NOx from construction vehicles, are expected. However, no significant impact is envisaged as long as the Environmental Management Construction Site Regulations (Legal Notice 295 of 2007) are adhered to. During operation, NOx will be generated by operational traffic but given its scale, the proposal per se will not generate significant amounts of traffic.

Storbju u vibrazzjonijiet

L-istorbju u l-vibrazzjonijiet waqt il-kostruzzjoni huma mistennija li jiġu limitati għal dawk normalment assoċjati ma' attivitajiet normali f'siti ta' kostruzzjoni. Matul l-operat mhux mistenni li l-istorbju u l-vibrazzjonijiet ikunu sinifikanti meta jitqies it-tip ta' proġett.

Noise and vibrations

Noise and vibration during construction are expected to be limited to those typically associated with normal construction site activities. During operations, noise and vibration are not expected to be significant given the type of project.

Impatti fuq il-wirt kulturali

L-iżvilupp propost huwa mdawwar minn numru ta' siti li jistgħu jkollhom valur arkeoloġiku. L-iżvilupp għandu jikkunsidra li jistgħu jinstabu xi fdalijiet arkeoloġiċi fuq is-sit u għalhekk f'dan l-istadju jinħtieġ sħarriġ arkeoloġiku tas-sit in kwistjoni sakemm ma jkunx hemm struzzjonijiet differenti mis-Sovrintendenza tal-Patrimonju Kulturali.

Impact on cultural heritage

The proposed development is surrounded by a number of archaeologically sensitive sites. The development should take into consideration that archaeological remains might be found on site and thus an archaeological survey of the site in question is required at this stage unless otherwise instructed by the Superintendence of Cultural Heritage (SCH).

Impatt permezz ta' dawl Matul il-lejl, huwa previst tidwil mill-bini u mill-mogħdijiet. Madankollu, il-ħruġ ta' dawl meta mqabbel mas-sitwazzjoni li diġà teżisti jista' jitnaqqas billi l-ammont ta' dawl matul il-lejl jinżamm mal-livelli minimi meħtieġa għal raġunijiet ta' sigurtà, u billi jintużaw fanali xierqa.

Light pollution During night time, lighting from the building and along pathways is envisaged. Nevertheless, light emissions above the current baseline situation may be reduced by limiting nocturnal lighting to the minimum required for security purposes, and through use of appropriate luminaries.
