BI QBIL mar-Regolament 3(8) tar-Regolamenti tal-2007 dwar l-Istima tal-Impatt fuq l-Ambjent (L.S. 549.46) fir-rigward tal-applikazzjoni msemmija hawn taħt, l-Awtorità għall-Ambjent u r-Riżorsi jidhrilha li l-proposta mhux probabbli li tirriżulta f'impatti ambjentali li li jistgħu jiġu indirizzati b'mod effettiv fl-Istudju dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali. Għalhekk id-Direttur jaqbel li l-proposta ma teħtiġx Dikjarazzjoni dwar l-Ippjanar Ambjentali (EPS). Dan hu mingħajr preġudizzju għall-oġġezzjonijiet ambjentali pendenti li jappartienu għall-użu tal-art u l-wirt kulturali diskussi hawn taħt.

Id-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) li giet ipprezentata bħala parti mill-applikazzjoni kkunsidrat b'mod suffiċjenti l-kwistjonijiet li jolqtu l-ambjent u għaldaqstant it-thejjija ta' Dikjarazzjoni dwar l-Ippjanar Ambjentali mhux se żżid informazzjoni ġdida peress li l-Awtorità għall-Ambjent u r-Riżorsi għandha l-informazzjoni kollha meħtieġa sabiex tiddeċiedi dwar din l-applikazzjoni kif gie konkluz fil-valutazzjoni tal-proġett li saret skont l-Iskeda IB tal-istess Regolamenti.

Il-proliferazzjoni ta' żvilupp f'żona li mhix żviluppata ħafna, mhix fl-interess tal-konservazzjoni taż-żona rurali. Hemm wkoll kwistjoni li tirrigwarda l-ġustifikazzjoni għall-firxa ta' teħid tal-art għal-bini u *hard landscaping* (eż: fir-rigward tal-firxa tal-impenn tas-sit), u għalhekk jaffettwaw b'mod inkrementali l-impatt nett tal-iżvilupp. Madankollu, dawn huma l-aħjar indirizzati permezz tal-ipproċessar ambjentali kontinwu tal-każ.

Statement**

IN conformity with Regulation 3(8) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (S.L. 549.46) with respect to the application mentioned hereunder the Environment and Resources Authority has determined that the proposal is unlikely to result in environmental impacts that can be effectively addressed in an Environmental Impact Assessment. Therefore, the Director agrees that the proposal does not require the preparation of an Environmental Planning Statement (EPS). This is without prejudice to the outstanding environmental objections to the application pertaining to land use and cultural heritage as discussed below.

The Project Description Statement (PDS) presented as part of the application has considered the environmental issues in a sufficient manner such that the preparation of an EPS would not add any new information and the Environment and Resources Authority has all the necessary information to determine the application as concluded in the project screening according to Schedule IB of the same Regulations.

A detailed justification is presented below:

Location: Site at, Ta' B' Xejn, Żurrieq

Proposal: Construction of a rabbit farm
including the installation of
pv panels and replace/repair
existing dilapidated rubble wall.

The following potential environmental impacts were identified and mitigation measures proposed in the Project Description Statement (PDS) submitted to the Environment and Resources Authority on the 1st July, 2016, and the justification for the exemption from carrying out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) submitted on the 31st August, 2016.

<i>Land Use</i>	<i>The proliferation of development in an otherwise sparsely developed area is not in the conservation interests of the rural area. There are also issues regarding the justification for the extent of land take for built-up and hard-surfaced areas (e.g. the nature and extent of the site commitment), thus incrementally affecting the net impact of the development. However these concerns are best addressed through continued environmental processing of the case.</i>
Holqien ta' skart	L-iskart iġġenerat jista' jiġi mmaniġjat mid-demmiela u numru ta' fosos li huma intrinżiċi għall-infrastruttura ta' razzett, kif huwa stabbilit mir-reqwiziti tal-kodiċi ta' prattika tajba fil-biedja. Barra minn hekk, il-ġestjoni tal-iskart u l-mizuri ta' mitigazzjoni għandhom jiġu mmaniġjati permezz tal-proċess tal- <i>environmental permitting</i> , u għandhom jagħmlu użu ta' sistemi ta' ġestjoni tal-iskart stabbiliti.
<i>Waste generation</i>	<i>Waste management facilities including a manure clamp and a number of cesspits are intrinsic to farm infrastructure as established by the code of good agricultural practice requirements. Furthermore, waste management and mitigation measures should be managed through environmental permitting mechanism, also making use of established waste management systems.</i>
Impatt fuq il-kwalità tal-arja	Waqt il-kostruzzjoni, huwa mistenni li jitqanqlu xi trabijiet mit-tindif u mit-tħaffir tas-sit. Madankollu, l-ebda impatt sinifikanti mhux mistenni minhabba d-daqs tal-iżvilupp. Ir-Regolamenti dwar L-Immaniġġar Ambjentali tas-Siti tal-Kostruzzjoni, (Legiżlazzjoni Sussidjarja 552.09) għandhom jiġu osservati. Waqt l-operat, emissjonijiet oħra x'aktarx li jkunu insinifikanti.
<i>Impact on air quality</i>	<i>During construction, fugitive dust from site clearance and excavation is expected. However, no significant impact is envisaged given the scale of the proposed project. The Environmental Management Construction Site Regulations (Subsidiary Legislation 552.09) are required to be adhered to. During operation, additional emissions are likely to be insignificant.</i>
Storbju u vibrazzjonijiet	L-istorbju u l-vibrazzjonijiet waqt il-kostruzzjoni huma mistennija li jkunu limitati għal dawk normalment assoċjati ma' attivitajiet normali f'siti ta' kostruzzjoni. Waqt il-fażi tal-operat, l-istorbju u l-vibrazzjonijiet mhumiex mistennija li jkunu sostanzjali. Barra minn hekk, ir-Regolamenti dwar L-Immaniġġar Ambjentali tas-Siti tal-Kostruzzjoni, (Legiżlazzjoni Sussidjarja 552.09) għandhom jiġu osservati.
<i>Noise and vibrations</i>	<i>Noise and vibration during construction are expected to be limited to those typically associated with normal construction site activities. During operation, noise and vibrations are not expected to be substantial. Furthermore, the Environmental Management Construction Site Regulations (Subsidiary Legislation 552.09) are required to be adhered to.</i>
Kwalità tal-Ilma	Is-sit jinsab ftit 'il barra mill-limiti ta' <i>groundwater safeguard zone</i> . Id-drenaġġ ta' ilma mhux iffiltrat jew mhux trattat minn art impermeabbli għal ġewwa sistema ta' fosos immaniġjata se jnaqqas ir-riskji potenzjali ta' kontaminazzjoni tal-ambjent tal-madwar. Ġestjoni tal-iskart u l-mizuri ta' mitigazzjoni għandhom jiġu valutati u ġestiti permezz tal-ipproċessar ambjentali kontinwu tal-każ, u permezz tal-proċess tal- <i>environmental permitting</i> .
<i>Water Quality</i>	<i>The site lies just outside the limits of the groundwater safeguard zone. The drainage of unfiltered or untreated water runoff from impermeable floors into a managed system of cesspits will reduce the potential risk of contamination of the surrounding environment. Waste management and mitigation measures will be assessed and managed through continued environmental assessment of the case, and the environmental permitting mechanism.</i>

Minkejja dak li jissema hawn fuq, l-Awtorità għall-Ambjent u r-Riżorsi żżomm id-dritt li titlob lill-applikant li jissottometti informazzjoni oħra kif jista' jkun meħtieġ biex tinforma l-proċess tad-deċiżjoni.
