tal-Impatt Ambjentali**

**Notification of Exemption of Environmental
Planning Statement**

BI qbil mar-Regolament 3(8) tar-Regolamenti tal-2007 dwar l-Istima tal-Impatt fuq l-Ambjent (Avviż Legali 114 tal-2007), u minhabba li l-Awtorità ta' Malta dwar l-Ambjent u l-Ippjanar jidhrilha li l-proposta mhux probabbli li jkollha impatti sinjifikanti fuq l-ambjent, id-Direttur għall-Harsien tal-Ambjent jaqbel li l-proposta ma teħtieġx Studju dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali (EPS).

IN conformity with Regulation 3(8) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (Legal Notice 114 of 2007), and in view of the fact that MEPA has determined that the proposal is unlikely to have significant environmental impacts, the Director of Environment Protection agrees that the proposal does not require the preparation of an Environmental Planning Statement (EPS).

Id-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) li giet ippreżentata bħala parti mill-applikazzjoni kkunsidrat b'mod suffiċjenti l-kwistjonijiet li jolqtu l-ambjent u għaldaqstant it-tnejja ta' studju dwar l-impatt ambjentali mhux se żżid informazzjoni ġdida peress li l-Awtorità għandha l-informazzjoni kollha meħtieġa sabiex tiddeciedi dwar din l-applikazzjoni. Skont l-informazzjoni li giet ippreżentata fid-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) u fil-valutazzjoni li saret skont l-Iskeda IB tal-istess Regolamenti, ma jidhirx li l-proposta se jkollha impatti sinjifikanti fuq l-ambjent.

The Project Description Statement (PDS) presented as part of the application has considered the environmental issues in a sufficient manner such that the preparation of an EPS would not add any new information and MEPA has all the necessary information to determine the application. From the information presented in the PDS and screening according to Schedule IB of the same Regulations, the proposal is not likely to have significant environmental effects.

Proposta: PA 05672/09: Bini ta' tliet garaxxijiet industrijali sovrastanti f'barriera eżistenti tal-gebla tal-franka. (Żewġ garaxxijiet ta' fuq diġà approvati).

PA 05904/09: Biex jinbnew garaxxijiet għall-ħażna ta' tagħmir/makkinarju relatat mal-attività tal-barriera.

Location: Quarry 18, Ta' l-Għarix, Triq is-Sigġiewi, Qrendi

Proposal: PA 05672/09: To construct three overlying industrial garages in an existing soft stone quarry. (Two upper garages already approved).

PA 05904/09: To construct garages for the storage of equipment/machinery in relation to quarrying activity.

Dawn l-effetti potenzjali fuq l-ambjent, flimkien ma' numru ta' mizuri biex jittaffa l-impatt, ġew identifikati fid-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) li kien sottomess lill-Awtorità fil-25 ta' Lulju, 2013 u fil-ġustifikazzjoni għall-eżenzjoni mill-Istudju dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali li giet sottomessa fil-31 ta' Lulju, 2013.

The following potential environmental impacts were identified and mitigation measures proposed in the Project Description Statement (PDS) submitted to MEPA on the 25th July, 2013 and the justification for proposal from carrying out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) submitted on 31st July, 2013.

L-użu tal-art Il-garaxxijiet proposti, maħsuba biss għall-ħażna tat-tagħmir u vetturi tal-barriera, jinsabu ġewwa barriera eżistenti tal-gebel tal-franka. L-istrutturi mhumiex previsti li jaqbzū l-livell eżistenti

tat-triq u għalhekk m'hemm l-ebda impatt ambjentali sinifikanti minn perspettiva viżiva. Dan il-proġett, billi huwa wieħed temporanju, mhux qed jitqies li jxekkel ir-restawr aħhari tas-sit lura f'art agrikola (kif approvat fi PA 03834/04). Dan huwa bil-fehma li l-garaxxijiet jintużaw b'konnessjoni mal-attività tal-barriera u jiżzarmaw mal-waqfien tal-estrazzjoni tal-minerali (huwa smat li l-barriera għandha riżorsa għal madwar 20 sena).

Land use

The proposed garages, intended solely for the storage of quarrying equipment and vehicles, are located within an operational soft stone quarry. The structures are not envisaged to exceed the existing road level thus there is no significant environmental impacts from a visual point of view. Being temporary, the proposal is not considered to hinder the ultimate restoration of the site back to agricultural land (as approved in PA 03834/04). This is on the understanding that the garages are used in relation to the quarrying activity and are dismantled on cessation of the mineral extraction (estimated quarrying extraction lifetime is c. 20 years).

Ilma tal-Pjan

Is-sit jinsab f'Zona ta' Protezzjoni tal-aquifer u fil-vicinanza ta' zona fejn jingabar l-ilma (*Water Catchment Area - South Malta Local Plan Policy SMCO 08*). Matul l-operat, x'aktarx li jiġi generat skart relatat mal-manutenzjoni tal-vetturi u t-tagħmir tal-barrieri maħżuna. Impatti fuq l-aquifer se jittaffew permezz ta' miżuri li jinkludi l-qiegħ u art impermeabbli biex jiġi evitat/jinżamm tixrid aċċidentali. Qed jiġu proposti ġibjuni biex jingabar l-ilma tal-wiċċ li joriġina mis-sit. Impatti fuq l-aquifer mhumiex probabbli li jkunu sinifikanti dment li jittiehdu miżuri kif suppost biex jiġu evitati kwalunkwe effetti negattivi fuq l-ilma tal-pjan.

Groundwater

The site falls within an Aquifer Protection Zone and in the vicinity of a Water Catchment Area (South Malta Local Plan Policy SMCO 08). During operation, the proposals are likely to generate waste related to the servicing of the stored quarrying vehicles and equipment. Impacts to the aquifer will be mitigated through measures including bunded areas and impervious ground to avoid/contain spillages and accidental leaks. Reservoirs are being proposed to collect surface water runoff originating from the site. Impacts on the aquifer are not likely to be significant as long as measures are duly taken to avoid any likely negative effects on the groundwater.

Ġestjoni tal-Iskart

Numru ta' vetturi abbandunati u skart tal-metall huma preżenti fuq is-sit. Dawn johlqu perikolu ta' tniġġiż partikolarment billi s-sit jinsab f'zona ta' protezzjoni tal-aquifer. Dan ikun jeħtieġ rimi xieraq skont il-ligi u f'konformità ma' dikjarazzjoni għall-metodu tat-tindif (*cleaning method statement*). Iż-żewġ proposti m'għandhomx jitqiesu aktar sakemm din id-dikjarazzjoni titwettag b'mod adegwat għas-sodisfazzjon tal-MEPA.

Waste Management

A number of abandoned vehicles and scrap metal are present on site, posing a pollution hazard, particularly noting that the site is within an aquifer protection zone. This will require appropriate disposal in accordance with legislation and an approved cleaning method statement. Both proposals shall not be considered further until a cleaning method statement is adequately prepared to MEPA's satisfaction.

Minkejja dak li jissema hawn fuq, l-Awtorità ta' Malta dwar l-Ambjent u l-Ippjanar iżzomm id-dritt li titlob lill-applikant li jissottometti informazzjoni oħra kif jista' jkun meħtieġ biex tiegħu deċiżjoni dwar l-applikazzjoni.
