**Notification of Exemption of
Environmental Planning Statement**

BI qbil mar-Regolament 3(8) tar-Regolamenti tal-2007 dwar l-Istima tal-Impatt fuq l-Ambjent (Avviż Legali 114 tal-2007), u minhabba li l-Awtorità ta' Malta dwar l-Ambjent u l-Ippjanar jidhrilha li l-proposta mhux probabbli li jkollha impatti sinifikanti fuq l-ambjent, id-Direttur għall-Harsien tal-Ambjent jaqbel li l-proposta ma teħtieġx Studju dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali (EPS).

IN conformity with Regulation 3(8) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (Legal Notice 114 of 2007), and in view of the fact that MEPA has determined that the proposal is unlikely to have significant environmental impacts, the Director of Environment Protection agrees that the proposal does not require the preparation of an Environmental Planning Statement (EPS).

Id-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) li għet ipprezentata bħala parti mill-applikazzjoni kkunsidrat b'mod suffiċjenti l-kwistjonijiet li jolqtu l-ambjent u għaldaqstant it-tnejja ta' studju dwar l-impatt ambjentali mhux se jzid informazzjoni ġdida peress li l-Awtorità għandha l-informazzjoni kollha meħtieġa sabiex tiddeciedi dwar din l-applikazzjoni. Skont l-informazzjoni li għet ipprezentata fid-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) u fil-valutazzjoni li saret skont l-Iskeda IB tal-istess Regolamenti, ma jidhri li l-proposta se jkollha impatti sinifikanti fuq l-ambjent.

The Project Description Statement (PDS) presented as part of the application has considered the environmental issues in a sufficient manner such that the preparation of an EPS would not add any new information and MEPA has all the necessary information to determine the application. From the information presented in the PDS and screening according to Schedule IB of the same Regulations, the proposal is not likely to have significant environmental effects.

Dawn l-effetti potenzjali fuq l-ambjent, flimkien ma' numru ta' miżuri biex jitaffa l-impatt, ġew identifikati fid-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) li kien sottomess lill-Awtorità fil- 25 ta' Jannar 2013 u fil-ġustifikazzjoni għall-eżenzjoni mill-Istudju dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali li għet sottomessa fil-21 ta' Frar, 2013.

The following potential environmental impacts were identified and mitigation measures proposed in the Project Description Statement (PDS) submitted to MEPA on the 25th January 2013 and the justification for proposal from carrying out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) submitted on 21st February, 2013.

Holqien ta' skart

Il-proġett se jiġġenera skart kemm waqt il-fażi ta' kostruzzjoni kif ukoll waqt l-operat. Skart inert iġġenerat matul il-fażi ta' kostruzzjoni mhux meqjus sinifikanti. L-iskart li se jiġi ġġenerat matul il-kostruzzjoni se jinkludi skart ta' kostruzzjoni u demolizzjoni, li huwa stmat għal madwar 150,000m³. Parti mill-materjal li jirrizulta mit-twaqqiġ tal-bini eżistenti se jerga' jintuza fis-sit għall-irdim u għall-kostruzzjoni tal-ħzin temporanju. Il-bqija tal-materjal se jingarr mis-sit għar-rimi f'*inert landfill* kif ikun speċifikat mill-Awtoritajiet kompetenti. Waqt l-operat, il-proposta mhix mistennija li tiġġenera ammonti sinifikanti ta' skart tal-ippakkjar u skart municipli, l-iktar mill-uffiċċji, djar residenzjali, u s-*supermarket*

<i>Waste generation</i>	<i>The project will generate waste during both construction and operation. Inert waste generated during the construction phase is not considered to be significant. Waste generated during construction is likely to comprise construction and demolition waste, estimated at around 150,000m³. Some of the material resulting from the demolition of the existing building will be re-used on site for back-fill and for the construction of the temporary hoarding. The rest of the material will be transported from the site for disposal at an inert landfill site as directed by the appropriate authorities. During operation, the proposal is not expected to generate significant amounts of packaging and municipal waste, namely from the offices, residential units, and the supermarket.</i>
<i>Storbju, vibrazzjonijiet kwalità tal-arja</i>	<i>Waqt il-kostruzzjoni, storbju, vibrazzjonijiet u trabijiet se jiġu ġġenerati matul it-tindif tas-sit, l-iskavar, u l-kostruzzjoni. Emissjonijiet tal-Nitrogen Oxide (NOx) u storbju mill-vetturi tal-kostruzzjoni huma ukoll mistennija. Madankollu, l-ebda impatt sinifikattiv m'hu mistenni dment li r-Regolamenti fuq il-Ġestjoni Ambjentali ta' Sit tal-Kostruzzjoni (Avviż Legali 295 tal-2007) jiġu osservati. Waqt l-operat, emissjonijiet tal-Nitrogen Oxide (NOx) u storbju mit-traffiku lejn u mis-supermarket/uffiċċji u residenzi jistgħu jiġu ġġenerati. Madankollu, peress li huwa mistenni li se jiġi ġġenerat massimu ta' 403 vjaġġi ta' vetturi waqt peak hours (bħala l-aġħar xenarju) u li l-akbar fluss ta' vetturi se jkun minn go Triq Sant' Andrija, l-impatt iġġenerat fiż-żona huwa meqjus bħala aċċettabbli.</i>
<i>Noise, vibration and air quality</i>	<i>During construction, noise, vibration and fugitive dust will be generated from site clearance, excavation, and construction. Nitrogen Oxide (NOx) emissions and noise from construction vehicles are expected. However, no significant impact is envisaged as long as the Environmental Management Construction Site Regulations (Legal Notice 295 of 2007) are adhered to. During operation, Nitrogen Oxide (NOx) emissions and noise from traffic to and from the supermarket/offices and residences may be generated. However, given that a maximum of 403 vehicular trips during the peak hours of the day (as the worst-case scenario) will be generated and that the major vehicular flows will be through Triq Sant' Andrija, such impact on the area is considered acceptable.</i>
<i>Kwalità tal-ilma</i>	<i>Il-parti ta' isfel tas-sit (i.e. il-faċċata tal-ex Lukanda Forum fuq Triq Sant' Andrija) tinsab tul it-thalweg tal-kanal ta' Wied Mejxu, u għalhekk suxxettibbli għall-għargħar. Madankollu, l-impatti mhux mistennija li jkunu sinifikanti, meta wieħed iqis il-hydrological catchment ta' Wied Mejxu. Għaldaqstant l-integrazzjoni tal-ilma tal-wiċċ u facilitajiet għal għbir ta' dan l-ilma (eż. kanali biex jikkontrollaw il-għbir tal-ilma żejjed mis-sit u għbjuni ta' kapacità adegwata għal għbir tal-ilma tal-wiċċ mis-sit) fl-iżvilupp ikun biżżejjed biex ittaffi l-impatti potenzjali.</i>
<i>Water quality</i>	<i>The lower part of the site (i.e. the frontage of the ex-Forum Hotel onto Triq Sant' Andrija) lies along the thalweg of the Wied Mejxu watercourse, and is therefore prone to a degree of flash-flooding. However, impacts are not expected to be significant, considering the limited hydrological catchment of Wied Mejxu. Nevertheless, the integration of runoff management and runoff harvesting facilities (e.g. controlled channelling of runoff through the site, and reservoirs of adequate capacity for harvesting site runoff) into the development would sufficiently mitigate potential impacts.</i>
<i>Impatt fuq il-wirt kulturali</i>	<i>Hemm il-possibbiltà li jinstabu fdalijiet arkeoloġiċi fuq is-sit propost waqt l-iskavar tas-sit. B'hekk tinhtieg konsultazzjoni mas-Sovrintendenza tal-Patrimonju Kulturali speċjalment dwar monitoraġġ tax-xogħlijiet.</i>
<i>Impact on cultural heritage</i>	<i>Archaeological remains may be uncovered during excavation. Thus, consultation with the Superintendence of Cultural Heritage (SCH) is required with regards to monitoring of works.</i>

Minkejja dak imsemmi hawn fuq, l-Awtorità ta' Malta dwar l-Ambjent u l-Ippjanar iżzomm id-dritt li titlob lill-applikant li jissottometti informazzjoni oħra kif jista' jkun mehtieg biex tiddeċiedi l-applikazzjoni.
