BI qbil mar-Regolament 3(8) tar-Regolamenti tal-2007 dwar l-Istima tal-Impatt fuq l-Ambjent (S.L. 549.46), u minhabba li l-Awtorità għall-Ambjent u r-Riżorsi jidhrilha li l-proposta mhux probabbli li jkollha impatti sinifikanti fuq l-ambjent, id-Direttur jaqbel li l-proposta ma teħtieġx Studju dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali (EPS).

Id-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) li għet ipprezentata bħala parti mill-applikazzjoni kkunsidrat b'mod suffiċjenti l-kwistjonijiet li jolqtu l-ambjent u għaldaqstant it-teħjiġ ta' Studju Dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali mhux se jżid informazzjoni ġdida peress li l-Awtorità għall-Ambjent u r-Riżorsi għandha l-informazzjoni kollha meħtieġa sabiex tiddeċiedi dwar din l-applikazzjoni. IN conformity with Regulation 3(8) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (S.L. 549.46) with respect to the application mentioned hereunder and in view of the fact that the Environment and Resources Authority has determined that the proposal is unlikely to have significant environmental impacts, the Director agrees that the proposal does not require the preparation of an Environmental Planning Statement (EPS).

The Project Description Statement (PDS) presented as part of the application has considered the environmental issues in a sufficient manner such that the preparation of an Environmental Planning Statement (EPS) would not add any new information and the Environment and Resources Authority has all the necessary information to determine the application. From the information presented in the Project Description Statement (PDS) and screening according to Schedule IB of the same Regulations, the proposal is not likely to have significant environmental effects.

Proposal: Demolition of existing structures including the dismantling and disposal of asbestos containing materials.

Proposta: Thaffir għall-livelli meħtieġa u l-bini ta' Malta Carnival Experience inkluż workshops interattivi, parkeġġ, pjazza, *substation* u struttura għall-użi differenti li tikkonsisti f' mużew, ċentru awdjo viżiv, studjo għaż-żfin, kafetterija klassi 4D, spazju għall-amministrazzjoni, u ħanut tas- souvenir klassi 4B.

Dawn l-impatti potenzjali fuq l-ambjent, flimkien ma' numru ta' miżuri biex jittaffa l-impatt, ġew identifikati fid-Deskrizzjoni tal-Proġett (PDS) li kien sottomess lill-Awtorità għall-Ambjent u r-Riżorsi fl-14 ta' Diċembru, 2015 u fil-ġustifikazzjoni għall-eżenzjoni mill-Istudju dwar l-Impatt Ambjentali li ġiet sottomessa fid-19 ta' Mejju, 2016.

Proposal: Excavation to the required levels and construction of the Malta Carnival Experience including interactive workshops, parking area, piazza, substation and a multi-purpose structure consisting of Museum, Audio visual centre, dance rehearsal studio, class 4D cafeteria, administration spaces and a class 4B souvenir shop.

The following potential environmental impacts were identified and mitigation measures proposed in the Project Description Statement (PDS) submitted to the Environment and Resources Authority on 14th December, 2015 and the justification for the exemption from carrying out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) submitted on 19th May, 2016.

Holqien ta' skart

Ix-xoghlijiet proposti johlqu riskju għas-saħħa assoċjat mat-tneħħija ta' materjal li jkun fih l-asbestos (ACM). Madankollu l-ebda impatt ambjentali sinifikanti mhu previst sakemm ix-xoghlijiet jkunu eżegwiti b' mod responsabbli u l-miżuri ta' prekawzjoni kollha jiġu strettament segwiti. It-tneħħija u t-trattament ta' ACM għandu jitwettaq skont ir-rekwiziti tar-Regolamenti dwar Prevenzjoni u Tnaqqis ta' Tniġġis tal-Ambjent mill-Asbestos (L.S. 549.18), u r-rekwiziti tal-Awtorità għas-Saħħa u s-Sigurtà Fuq il-Post tax-Xogħol.

Waste generation

The proposed works pose a health risk associated with the removal of Asbestos Containing Material (ACM). Nevertheless no significant environmental impacts are envisaged provided that the works are executed responsibly and all the precautionary measures are strictly adhered to. The removal and handling of ACM is to be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Prevention and Reduction of Environmental Pollution by Asbestos Regulations (S.L. 549.18), and the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Authority.

Impatt fuq il-kwalità tal-arja

L-ebda impatti sinifikanti fuq il-kwalità tal-arja ma huma previsti fil-konsiderazzjoni tal-karatteristiċi eżistenti tal-madwar, u sakemm ikunu segwiti strettament l-miżuri kollha ta' prekawzjoni. Il-konformità mar-rekwiziti mar-Regolamenti dwar L-Immaniġġar Ambjentali tas-Siti tal-Kostruzzjoni, (L.S. 552.09) għandu jkun suffiċjenti biex jiġu kkontrollati l-emissjonijiet tat-trab waqt il-kostruzzjoni. L-operat huwa mistenni li jirriżulta f' zieda fit-traffiku massimu medju annwali ta' kuljum ta' 600, li jista' jżid il-kongestjoni tat-traffiku kumulattiv fil-madwar, filwaqt li t-tfikkil tat-traffiku matul il-festi tal-karnival huwa mistenni.

Impact on air quality

No significant air quality impacts are envisaged in consideration of the existing characteristics of the larger area, and provided that all the precautionary measures are strictly adhered to. Compliance with the requirements of the Environmental Management Construction Site Regulations (S.L. 552.09) should be sufficient to suppress dust emissions during the construction phase. The operation phase is expected to result in an increased maximum annual average daily traffic of 600, which may exacerbate the cumulative traffic congestion in the wider area, whilst traffic disruptions during the carnival festivities are expected.

Kuntest Viżwali

Filwaqt li ma huma previsti l-ebda impatt viżivi sinifikanti, huwa rrakkomandat li jiġu sottomessi photomontages biex jiġi esplorat iżjed ir-relazzjoni viżwali tal-proġett mal-kuntest kulturali tal-inħawi.

Visual Context

Whilst no significant visual impacts are envisaged, it is recommended that photomontages are submitted exploring the visual relation of the project to the cultural setting of the surroundings.

Minkejja dak imsemmi hawn fuq, l-Awtorità għall-Ambjent u r-Riżorsi żżomm id-dritt li titlob lill-applikant li jissottometti informazzjoni oħra kif jista' jkun meħtieġ biex tiddeċiedi l-applikazzjoni.
