(KAP. 356)****Skedar ta' Proprjetà**

B'RIFERENZA għan-Notifikazzjoni tal-Gvern Nru 935 (Gazzetta tal-Gvern Nru. 17,992 tas-7 ta' Novembru, 2006) l-Awtorità ta' Malta dwar l-Ambjent u l-Ippjanar b'din tiddikjara li qiegħda tneħħi parti mill-proprjetà msemmija hawn taħt (li tidher fuq il-mappa f'pagna 6407) mil-lista ta' proprjetà skedata, skond l-artikolu 46 ta' l-Att dwar l-Ippjanar ta' l-Iżvilupp. Originarjament dan l-iskedar kien jinkludi parti minn barriera liċenzata (HG1), kif ukoll sit li ddaħħal fiż-żona ta' l-iżvilupp bħala parti mill-*ischeme rationalization exercise*, jiġifieri:-

**Għajn Barrani u l-Qortin ta' Għajn Damma, limiti
tax-Xaghra u ż-Żebbuġ, Ghawdex**

Il-Ministru għall-Affarijiet Rurali u l-Ambjent, fid-29 ta' Frar, 2008, kien approva li parti minn din il-proprjetà għandha tiġi mneħħija mil-lista ta' proprjetà skedata, skond l-Artikolu 46(10) ta' l-Att dwar l-Ippjanar ta' l-Iżvilupp.

L-Awtorità ta' Malta dwar l-Ambjent u l-Ippjanar teżerċita s-setgħat tagħha ta' twestiq, kif imfissra f'artikoli 46, 52, 53 u 55 ta' l-Att, fil-każ ta' xi ksur tad-dispożizzjonijiet ta' l-Att dwar l-Ippjanar ta' l-Iżvilupp f'dak li jirrigwarda proprjetà skedata.

No. 369**DEVELOPMENT PLANNING ACT
(CAP. 356)****Scheduling of Property**

WITH reference to Government Notice No. 935 (Government Gazette No. 17,992 of 7th November 2006), the Malta Environment and Planning Authority declares that it is removing part of the following property (as shown on site plan on page 6407) from the list of scheduled property, in terms of section 46 of the Development Planning Act. Originally the scheduling boundary included part of a licensed quarry (HG1) and a site that was subsequently included within the development zone during the scheme rationalization exercise, namely:

**Għajn Barrani and il-Qortin ta' Għajn Damma,
limits of Xaghra/Żebbuġ, Gozo**

The Minister for Rural Affairs and the Environment, on 29th February, 2008, has approved that part of this property is removed from the list of scheduled property in accordance with section 46(10) of the Development Planning Act.

The Malta Environment and Planning Authority will exercise its powers of enforcement, as set out in sections 46, 52, 53 and 55 of the Act, in the case of any contravention to the provisions of the Development Planning Act as regards to Scheduled Property.
