**Industrial Emissions (Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations  
(S.L. 549.77)**

This letter supersedes previous Permit Letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> April 2018 with Ref: EPD/A/SF/18/439.

The Environment and Resources Authority (ERA) Board determined that the IPPC permit (IP 0001/12) covering the operations detailed in the application described above, shall be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. Operations are to conform to the standards and operating conditions specified in the IPPC permit document (IP 0001/12/A) and associated approved documents as listed above.
2. Prior to the issue of the permit the applicant shall submit the permit processing fee to the amount of € 30,000 addressing activities 5.1 (c), 5.1(d) and 5.5 in schedule 1 of SL 549.77 (€20,000 for activity 5.1 and €10,000 for activity 5.5)
3. Prior to issue of this permit, the applicant is to submit the following financial guarantees:
  - a) €25,500 covering the pre-operational conditions in section 1.7 and submissions of the Improvement Program according to Table 1.4.1 of the Permit. This financial guarantee shall be maintained until the Authority confirms in writing that conditions 1.4.1 and 1.7 of the Permit have been satisfactorily addressed.

- b) € 21,225 to secure all the other obligations under this permit. This Financial Guarantee shall be maintained by the Permit Holder from the date that the Financial Guarantee is secured throughout the lifetime of the Permit.

Both Bank Guarantees shall be renewed annually. Following renewal and/or variations to this permit, the Authority may require amendments to the Bank Guarantee.

4. The Authority may take part or all of the bank guarantee if the Permit Holder fails to take the necessary action, in cases of non-compliance with these permit conditions, the Act or any subsidiary legislation thereof, or in cases where environmental integrity is threatened. This bank guarantee is without prejudice to any environmental liabilities incurred by the operator through failure to adhere with permit conditions. Should the Authority forfeit the Bank Guarantee either in part or in full, the permit holder shall ensure that this is replenished without undue delay
5. Additionally, prior to the issue of the permit the fixed annual contribution of €3,000 is to be remitted by the permit holder to cover the annual fees for the first year of operations under this.

Future remittances will consist of the fixed annual amount of €3,000 and a variable addition reflecting ERA's cost for inspections at €200 per inspection for inspections carried out in the previous year. The fixed annual amount of €3,000 will be reduced to €1,500 should the installation obtain a certified environmental management system.

The inspection costs depend on the actual number of site inspections, which is determined by the performance of the operator and the environmental risk associated with the installation. This total annual contribution has to be paid before the anniversary of the date of issue of this permit.
