

INTEGRATED POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPPC) AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The Environment and Resources Authority is hereby informing the public that “Enemalta plc”, “Delimara 3 Power Generation Ltd.” and “Electrogas Malta” have applied to the Environment and Resources Authority for a variation and renewal of the Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) permit IP0002/07/E which is to include the operation of Delimara 1, Delimara 2a and 2b, Delimara 3 (conversion from HFO to Natural Gas), Delimara 4 CCGT and LNG Terminal at the Delimara Power Station. The installation is located at Triq il-Power Station in the Local Council of Marsaxlokk.

The application contains a description of any foreseeable significant effects of emissions from the installation on the environment.

In addition, ERA is also in receipt of the EIA Addendum to the Environmental Impact Statement carried out for Delimara Gas and Power - Combined cycle gas turbine (CCGT) and liquified natural gas receiving storage, and re-gasification facilities, and, construction of jetty and ancillary facilities.

Information relating to the IPPC application submitted by the above operators for the variation and renewal of the IPPC permit for the Delimara Power Station and the EIA Addendum is held at the following locations:
