**Industrial Emissions (Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations  
S.L. 549.77**

The Environment and Resources Authority (ERA) determined that the IPPC permit (IP 0001/14/B) covering the operations detailed in the application described above, shall be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. Submission of a financial guarantee of €23,400 to secure the obligations under this permit which shall be renewed annually. This guarantee will have to be maintained throughout the lifetime of the permit. Following renewal and/or variations to this permit, the Authority may require amendments to the Bank Guarantee
2. Payment to ERA of the sum of €6,600 to cover the annual contribution for 2016 - 2019 (€1,500 per year) and inspections carried out in 2015-2018 (3 inspections at €200 each).
3. Future remittances will consist of the fixed annual amount of €1,500 and a variable addition reflecting ERA's cost for inspections. The latter variable component depends on the actual number of site inspections, which is determined by the performance of the operator. The total annual contribution has to be paid before the anniversary of the date of issue of this permit.
4. This permit is granted saving third party rights. The applicant/permit holder is not excused from obtaining any other permission required by law.

Any aggrieved person may appeal from this decision before the Environment and Planning Review Tribunal within 30 days from the issue of the permit in terms of Article 63 of the Environment Protection Act.
