### **Industrial Emissions (Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations (Legal Notice 10 of 2013)**

The Environment and Resources Authority (ERA) hereby grants consent to partially surrender the IPPC permit (IP0003/07/C) in accordance with the application described above, of the operations detailed in the attached IPPC permit document (IP0003/07/C) and associated approved documents.

This permit regulates the management and operational conduct of the site.

This permit is valid until 25 August 2021 however, it may be varied/surrendered/transferred as specified in pages 3 and 4 of the introductory note in the permit. An application for renewal of this permit is to be submitted at least six months prior to expiry of this permit and must show how the obligation in the improvement programme have been met.

This permit is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. Operations are to conform to the standards and operating conditions specified in the IPPC permit document (IP 0003/07/C) and associated approved documents as listed above.
2. Prior to issue of this permit, the applicant is to submit a financial guarantee of €34,500 to secure the obligations under this permit. The financial guarantee shall be maintained by the permit holder throughout the term of validity of this permit and shall only be released on surrender of the permit. In the event of forfeiture either partly or as a whole of the bank

guarantee, the operator shall immediately replenish the amount forfeited.

3. Prior to issue of the permit, the applicant shall pay ERA the sum of € 10,205 to cover the annual contribution for 2016 and, 2017 (€3225 per year), the annual contribution for 2018 (€2,155) and inspections in 2015, 2016, and 2017 (8 inspections at €200 per inspection)
4. Future remittances will consist of the fixed annual amount of €2,155 and a variable addition reflecting ERA's cost for inspections. The latter variable component depends on the actual number of site inspections, which is determined by the performance of the operator. This total annual contribution has to be paid before the anniversary of the date of issue of this permit. Variations in ERA's inspection expenditure will be reflected in the following year's contribution.

This permit is granted saving third party rights. The applicant/permit holder is not excused from obtaining any other permission or authorisation required by law.
