**Industrial Emissions (Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations  
S.L. 549.77 – Surrender Notice**

The Environment and Resources Authority (ERA) Board determined that the IPPC permit (IP 0005/07/D) covering the operations detailed in the application described above, shall be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. Operations are to conform to the standards and operating conditions specified in the IPPC permit document (IP 0005/07/D) and associated approved documents as listed above.
2. Prior to issue of this permit, the applicant is to submit a financial guarantee of €12,600 to secure the obligations under this permit which shall be renewed annually. This guarantee will have to be maintained throughout the lifetime of the permit. Following renewal and/or variations to this permit, the Authority may require amendments to the Bank Guarantee.
3. The Authority may take part or all of the bank guarantee if the Permit Holder fails to take the necessary action, in cases of non-compliance with these permit conditions, the Act or any subsidiary legislation thereof, or in cases where environmental integrity is threatened. This bank guarantee is without prejudice to any environmental liabilities incurred by the operator through failure to adhere with permit conditions. Should the Authority forfeit the Bank Guarantee either in part or in full, the permit holder shall ensure that this is replenished without undue delay.
4. Additionally, prior to issue of the permit, the applicant shall pay ERA the sum of €5,100 to cover the annual contribution for 2016, 2017 and 2018 (€1,500 per year) and inspections carried out between 2015 and 2018 (3 inspections at €200 each).
5. Future remittances will consist of the fixed annual amount of €1,500 and a variable addition reflecting

ERA's cost for inspections. The latter variable component depends on the actual number of site inspections, which is determined by the performance of the operator. The total annual contribution has to be paid before the anniversary of the date of issue of this permit. Variations in ERA's inspection expenditure will be reflected in the following year's contribution.

This permit is granted saving third party rights. The applicant/permit holder is not excused from obtaining any other permission required by law.
