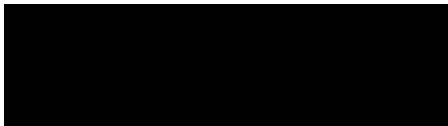

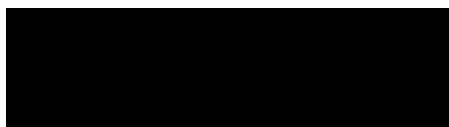

## **Section 13 - Information and Awareness Campaigns**

Green MT continued with a number of initiatives through 2011 in respect to public awareness and advertising campaigns directed to consumers and also operating contractors.

Eco-Councillors effected door-to-door visits in numerous localities including Sliema, M'Xlokk, Sta. Lucia, Naxxar, Mosta, Rabat, Dingli, Mtarfa and Mgarr.

A school recycling competition was effected in the period March to June 2011. Schools taking part were finally rewarded in Sliema, and accordingly certificates were distributed. Copy of sample certificate is enclosed.

Green MT continued with its yearly 4 month waste separation project at Ghadira Bay where a number of students participated under Green MT supervision. Over 38 waste separation bins were emptied daily from the beach twice daily Monday to Sunday. Green MT together with Mellieha Local Council worked together to achieve the aims of this project. Copy of the flyer which was distributed to people on beach is enclosed.

Green MT visited all Birkirkara households over a two month period and residents were asked to answer a questionnaire. Green MT explained to residents that as from February 2013 the Scheme would recover paperboard on Wednesday and Plastic/Metal on Friday. The result of this questionnaire was an overwhelming 70% acceptance to the new system which was to be implemented in 2013.

Green MT has over the months issued advertisements to make sure that the public is informed with respect to recoveries in Local Councils and amounts collected. Billboards were set up in a number of Local Councils. We are also providing the attached documents which include articles published on Newstring to over 7000 establishments. Articles related to Waste Packaging Compliance, adverts to oblige producers to comply to legislation, adverts on Malta Today and Let's Gozo, contributions towards cleaner localities. Provision of recycle bags to Rabat and Zurrieq residents.

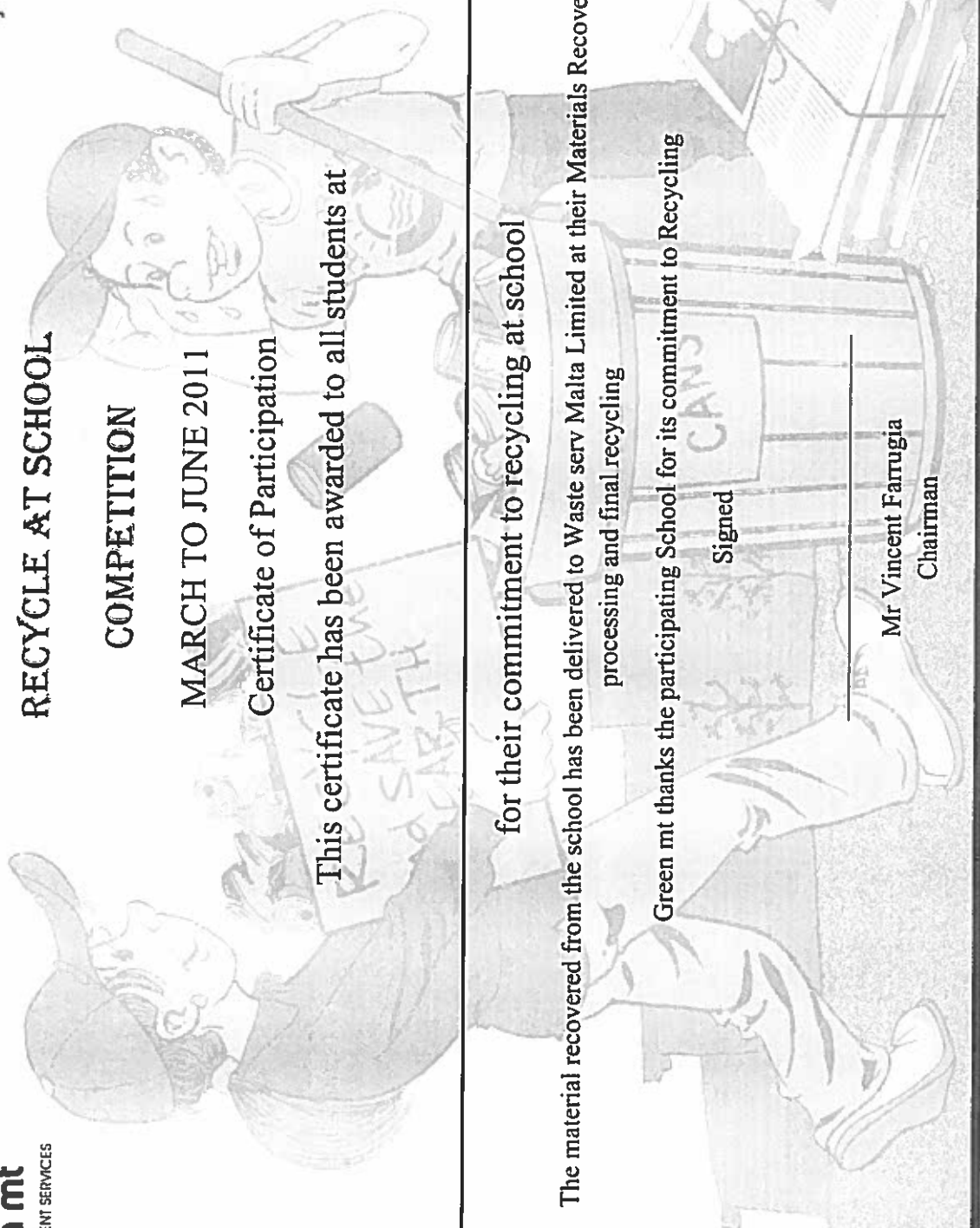
