**Restrictions on Placing on the Market of Single-Use Plastic
Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2021**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by article 3 of the Supplies and Services Act and by articles 54 and 55 of the Environment Protection Act, the Minister responsible for Commerce and the Minister the Environment, Climate Change, and Planning, after consultation with the Environment and Resources Authority, have made the following regulations:-

1. The title of these regulations is the Restrictions on Placing on Market of Single-Use Plastic Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 and these regulations shall be read and construed as one with the Restrictions on Placing on the Market of Single-Use Plastic Products Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".

2. In sub-regulation (1) of regulation 4 of the principal regulations, the words "shall be prohibited." shall be substituted by the words "shall be prohibited:" and immediately thereafter there shall be added the following new proviso:

"Provided that as from 1 January 2022, distribution, consumption or use in the course of a commercial activity, whether in return for payment or free of charge, of the single-use plastic products listed in Part A of the Schedule and products made from oxo-degradable plastic shall be prohibited."
