

Meeting	EIA Public Consultation in relation to the following proposal: EA/00021/21 (PA/05420/21) - Corinthia Oasis Ħal Ferħ Project title: Amended Application to PA 3134/19 - Construction of Corinthia Oasis - Works include amendments to previous permit - Construction of Hotel and 25 Residences. Site at: Corinthia Oasis (ex Ħal Ferħ Complex), Triq il-Kappella Tal-Militar, Triq in-Naħħalija, Mellieħa.

Mr. Alexander Camilleri opened the meeting, welcoming the attendees present in person and those connecting remotely via Microsoft Teams, and explained the subject of the meeting being the proposed development of the Corinthia Oasis at Ħal Ferħ, Mellieħa (PA/05420/21), which is currently subject to an Environmental Impact Assessment, with reference EA/00021/21.

Details vis-à-vis the purpose of the meeting were provided, in particular that the meeting is part of the EIA process, to present the EIA findings and to gather feedback from the public in due time for any relevant considerations to be factored in during the process, and is not the final decision-taking meeting.

The public was also informed that proceedings are minuted and that any additional comments can be submitted to ERA via email on eia.malta@era.org.mt or in writing via post, by 7th February 2025. There were no objections for the online meeting to be held in Maltese.

Dr Paul Gauci, the EIA coordinator, delivered a presentation, providing an introduction to the project and an overview of the environmental topics addressed in the EIA and their assessed impacts.

Mr. Alexander Camilleri opened the floor for comments after the presentation and reminded the online participants that they can also leave a comment in the Microsoft Teams Chat, which was being administered by ERA's staff.

No comments or questions were raised by the meeting attendees (neither in person nor online).
