

ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION ACT

(CAP. 549)

Waste (Amendment) Regulations, 20XX

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by articles 54 and 55 of the Environment Protection Act, the Minister for the environment after consultation with the Environment and Resources Authority, has made the following regulations:-

Title.
S.L. 549.63.

1. The title of these regulations is the Waste (Amendment) Regulations, 20XX and they shall be read and construed as one with the Waste Regulations, hereafter referred to as “the principal regulations”.

Adds new regulation to the principal regulations.

2. Immediately after regulation 12 of the principal regulations there shall be added the following new regulation:

“Separation of waste at source.

S.L. 549.40.

12A (1). It shall be the duty of every person to separate the following waste streams at source prior to their separate collection:

- (a) paper;
- (b) metal;
- (c) plastic;
- (d) glass;
- (e) bio-waste; and
- (f) any other waste stream as determined by the Minister:

Provided that co-mingled collection of certain streams may be allowable only if carried out in line with the provisions of Schedule 3 of the Abandonment, Dumping and Disposal of Waste in Streets and Public Places or Areas Regulations:

Further provided that for waste generated in public places, this obligation applies only where bins for the separate collection are available.

(2) Enforcement of sub-regulation (1) shall be carried out in a phased approach as shall be prescribed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette and

in line with regulation 10(4A) of the Abandonment, Dumping and Disposal of Waste in Streets and Public Places or Areas Regulations.”
