

## PA/06860/21 – Annex I

### Conditions.

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#### Notification of commencement

1. Prior to the commencement of any works on site, the ERA's Compliance and Enforcement Directorate (CED) shall be formally notified at least five (5) days ahead on: [ced.consult.era@era.org.mt](mailto:ced.consult.era@era.org.mt).

#### Construction-phase works

2. All works covered by the development permission shall be restricted to the area and depth approved for development, as shown on the plans at Eapps documents PA/06860/21 – 15c-d.
3. Access to the site shall be limited to the proposed vertical and the other three entrance/exits to the NFRP tunnels at Attard (tal-Hofra) off Triq il-Belt Valletta, Mosta off Vjal l-indipendenza and at Gzira, off Triq G. Miceli.
4. Any infrastructure including pipelines, ducts or sewers damaged accidentally in the course of works shall be immediately repaired to the required specifications in order to prevent environmental damage or pollution. In the event of environmental damage or pollution, the works that caused such damage or pollution shall cease with immediate effect, adequate and effective mitigation measures shall be put in place to prevent any worsening of the environmental damage or pollution, and the accident shall be reported to the responsible authorities and the Environment and Resources Authority (ERA).

#### Waste Management

5. Uncontaminated, inert material resulting from excavation, demolition and/or construction shall either:
  - a) be used within the same site, as long as such use is in line with the approved plans and other conditions of this permit; or
  - b) be transported in accordance with the relevant waste management regulations and deposited at sites duly authorised by the Environment and Resources Authority (ERA) to accept such waste.

#### Environmental Monitoring (reserved matter)

6. The tunnel shall not be put to use prior to ERA's approval of an Environmental Monitoring and Reporting Programme. This shall describe how the operational use of the tunnel will be monitored, recorded and reported in a timely manner to enable immediate action, as required. The monitoring programme shall address the relevant impacts and sensitive receptors identified in the Appropriate Assessment Report.
