Should these documents not be made available upon submission of the EIA report, ERA reserves the right to re-open the public consultation for an additional 30-days, over and above the timeframe stipulated in Regulation 19(1), as deemed fit.

You may wish to note that the EIA Report is a public document and will be made available for consultation.
